Learn to Ride: Campers 7-12 years old – Busing available. Program is meant for new riders who do not have any formal riding experience (never taken lessons or attended riding camp.)

Learn to Ride 2: Campers 7-12 years old – Busing available. Program is meant for riders who have the basics of steering independently and have done some posting trot. (Have attended camp previously or taken some lessons.) If your rider is more advanced or you are unsure of their level please call us to discuss.

Have a child that loves animals and is keen to learn to ride? Pawsitively Pets has a great program for our animal loving friends who also have a love for horses and want to be introduced to horseback riding! Our Learn to Ride program allows children to be introduced to the wonderful world of horses and riding and still have the chance to enjoy a couple of visits from the Pawsitively Pets animal team throughout the weeks. Program includes, daily horsemanship activities, horse interactions, 2 mounted riding lesson, hands-on animal presentations and horse related crafts/enrichment. Horse show for parents on final day.

Busing available from our Leaside, Swansea, Beaches & Markham locations for riding camp – please check the bus stops noted for each session.

Program information below are programs that will take place at our Riding Partner – Kingsway Equestrian

- Camp hours are 9am to 4pm (bus arrives between 9-9:15am in the morning at camp and we begin to load at 3:45pm to plan for a 4pm departure.)
- Program does not have the option for extended care unless there is a program operating at the bus stop the week you are registered – if you require extended care past the busing times please call the office prior to registering to see if this is an option. No extended care is available at any time at the Markham or Beaches location.
- **Busing is available at an additional cost.** Leaside 5-day session busing \$100 + HST; Swansea 5-day session busing: \$110 + HST, 4-day session \$90 + HST; Beaches 5-day session busing \$90 + HST; Markham 5-day session busing: \$75 + HST
- All fees include helmet rental, all campers will need to have a boot with a heel for camp – a rainboot works well

PLEASE NOTE – DISCOUNTS DO NOT COMBINE OUR SYSTEM WILL PROVIDE YOU WITH THE BEST DISCOUNT OPTION AT CHECKOUT. Sibling discounts are 5% off 2nd sibling or additional after that.

Early Bird Discount schedule: Available until March 31 – 10%

Camp fees are exempt from HST, but HST is charged for all busing/transportation fees.

Program will operate at 50% capacity to account for all Covid protocols and social distancing on the bus.

All campers must be 7 years old or older as of December 31 to sign up for the Learn to Ride Program

Pawsitively Pets Summer Camp Refund Policy: Refunds for all programs will be made in writing via email and will be refunded in accordance with the schedule below. Credit can be obtained for the full amount of the refund to use towards another program if the guidelines are met. Refunds are subject to a \$25 administrative fee (per camp session/per child,) deducted from the total allowable refund. Refunds will be issued in the format they were originally paid. Pawsitively Pets reserves the right to grant exceptions to the stated policy in situations including, but not limited to, illness and death in the immediate family. **No Refunds for Partial Program Attendance or Illness:** We do not provide refunds or credits when someone chooses to leave programs part way through. If your child is ill due to an infectious disease/illness/virus that will put other campers at risk and will need to be withdrawn from camp, a doctor's note will be required within 48 hours of the illness and a credit will be provided for 50% of the remaining camp/program fees that can be used anytime in the next 12 months towards a camp program. Virtually all of our expenses are incurred before the start of the camp or program. Similarly, we cannot give refunds or credits to people who have registered for more than one session if they choose during their first session not to attend another session. (The exception to this is if we are able to fill the spot with someone on our waiting list.) **Extreme Circumstances:** (Someone in your family is told they have 6 months to live, your house burns down, etc.) By all means, contact us! We are not heartless. We may ask for some kind of documentation and explanation, and we will be more flexible if we hear from you sooner rather than later. We will consider all situations individually.

COVID-Related Program Cancellation Information: Should we be required under a government order to cancel the in-person operation of our camp programs for the summer season, refunds will be provided minus a \$25 administration fee. Please note all refunds may take 6-8 weeks to process.

Summer Camp Refund Guidelines: Up to and including May 31 of the camp year – full refund (minus \$25 admin fee per child/per session.) After May 31st but 30 + days prior to your camp session – 50% refund. Less than 30 days prior to your camp session - NO REFUND AVAILABLE.

Cancellation due to infectious disease prior to the start of camp: If your child is ill due to an infectious disease/illness/virus that will put other campers at risk of serious health issues and will need to be withdrawn from camp a doctor's note will be required noting the serious risk of spread to other campers, within 48 hours of notifying the camp, and a credit will be provided for 50% of the camp/program fees that can be used anytime in the next 12 months towards a camp program. **Cancellation while camp is in-session:** We do not provide refunds or credits when someone chooses to leave programs part way through. If your child is ill due to an infectious disease/illness/virus that will put other campers at risk of serious health issues and will need to be withdrawn from camp a doctor's note will be required within 48 hours of the illness, noting the risk to other campers, and a credit will be provided for 50% of the remaining camp/program fees that can be used anytime in the next 12 months towards a camp program.
