Learn to Ride: Campers 7-12 years old – Busing available. Program is meant for new riders who do not have any formal riding experience (never taken lessons or attended riding camp.)

Learn to Ride 2: Campers 7-12 years old – Busing available. Program is meant for riders who have the basics of steering independently and have done some posting trot. (Campers for Level 2 would need to have attended camp 2-3x or have taken some riding lessons.) If your rider is more advanced or you are unsure of their level please call us to discuss.

Program information below are programs that will take place at our Riding Partner – Kingsway Equestrian which NOW OPERATES OUT OF RCRA – 4252 DAVIS DRIVE.

- Camp hours are 9am to 4pm (bus arrives at the farm between 9-9:15am in the morning at camp and we begin to load at 3:45pm to plan for a 4pm departure.)
- AM Bus pick-up at Brentcliffe is 8:15am and drop-off at the end of the day is 4:45pm.
- Program does not have the option for extended care.
- **Busing is available at an additional cost.** Leaside 5-day session busing \$100 + HST; 4-day session busing is \$75 + HST
- All fees include helmet rental, all campers will need to have a boot with a heel for camp – a rainboot works well.
- All campers need to bring a packed lunch, two snacks and two large water bottles.

PLEASE NOTE – THERE ARE NO DISCOUNTS AVAILABLE FOR RIDING CAMP.

Camp fees are exempt from HST, but HST is charged for all busing/transportation fees.

All campers must be 7 years old or older as of December 31 to sign up for the Learn to Ride Program

2023 PROGRAMS REFUND POLICY:

Pawsitively Pets Refund Policy – please ensure to refer to our REFUND or PROGRAM Page for the refund timelines for different programs. Refunds for all programs will be made in writing by email and will be refunded in accordance with the schedule below. Credit can be obtained for the full amount of the refund to use towards another program if the guidelines are met, and the program date is within the same calendar year. Refunds are subject to the noted administrative fee (per child session/per child) deducted from the total allowable refund. Refunds will be issued in the format they were originally paid.

COVID-Related Program Cancellation Information: Refunds will not be available for any of our programs this season if we are required to shut down due to a pandemic or other extreme circumstance. A credit for future programming will be provided for use within one calendar year.

No Refunds for Partial Program Attendance or Illness: We do not provide refunds or credits when someone chooses to leave programs part way through. Virtually all of our expenses are incurred before the start of the camp or program. Similarly, we cannot give refunds or credits to people who have registered for more than one session if they choose during their first session not to attend another session. (The exception to this is if we are able to fill the spot with someone on our waiting list. If the spot is filled by someone from the waiting list an admin fee of \$100 is applied.)

Extreme Circumstances: (Someone in your family is told they have 6 months to live, your house burns down, etc.) By all means, contact us! We're not heartless. We may ask for some kind of documentation and explanation, and we'll be more flexible if we hear from you sooner rather than later. We'll consider all situations individually.

Summer Camp Refunds with Notice:

Full refund minus \$35 admin fee (per camper) is available until May 31.

Up to 30 days before the start of camp 50% refund is available

29 days or less before the camp session begins – No refunds or credits. If we are able to fill your spot with a camper from our waiting list, we will provide a full refund minus a \$100 waitlist admin fee.

Please note all admin fees are per camper per transaction. If you are cancelling multiple camp sessions in one transaction, the admin fee will only be charged once, if you cancel different sessions at different times the admin fee is per transaction.
