



## **SUMMER CAMP COUNSELLOR POSITIONS!**

### **Qualifications**

- Desire and ability to work with children in an educational, interactive manner
- Ability to work well in a team environment
- Ability to accept supervision and guidance
- Good character, integrity, and adaptability
- Enthusiasm, sense of humour, patience, and self-control

### **Responsibilities**

- Learn the likes/ dislikes of each participant.
- Recognize and respond to opportunities for problem-solving in the group.
- Develop opportunities for interaction between campers and staff.
- Provide opportunities for discussion of individual or group problems or concerns.
- Fulfill all staff administrative duties.
- Follow day-to-day activity schedule and engage campers in activities.
- Assist in teaching or leading an activity, as assigned.
- Guide individual campers in participating successfully in all aspects of camp activities.
- Carry out established roles in enforcing camp safety regulations.
- Prepare for and actively participate in staff training, and meetings.
- Set a good example for campers and others including cleanliness, punctuality, sharing clean up and chores.
- Encourage respect for personal property, camp equipment, and facilities.
- Maintain good public relations with campers' parents.
- Submit all required reports on time and complete all camper parent calls within the assigned timeline.
- These are not the only duties to be performed. Some duties may be reassigned and other duties may be assigned as required.

**Required Education and Experience:**

2. The position is open to students going into grade 11 or older, college and university students are also encouraged to apply. If you are under this age requirement please check out our volunteer opportunities.

**Contract terms:** July 3 – September 1 – must be available for at least 7 weeks during this term Monday to Friday

1. This is a seasonal position from July 3 to September 1, all applicants must be available to work at least 7 weeks during this period. (Full week commitments Monday to Friday.)
2. Shifts are Monday to Friday between the hours of 8am – 5:30pm (shifts are scheduled in 7-8 hour workdays)
3. Ability to work outdoors in hot and rainy weather conditions.
4. Current First Aid & CPR or the ability to certify by June 20.
5. Ability to frequently lift up to 25 pounds.
6. Candidates must be available for all training dates in May & June. Some training will be self-directed online, and some will be in-person. All training takes place at our Leaside location. **Current training dates scheduled for May 16, May 25, June 1, June 6 & June 9 and June 29**

**Job Location:** Positions available for our Leaside site (mid-town Toronto) or West end Toronto – Bloor West Village

**Compensation:** Pay rate is a weekly salary. Our pay grid is defined by previous camp work experience and age, ranging from \$450 - \$600 per week. Contract completion bonus paid out at the end of the summer term. Camp pay is under the Ontario Government Student workers guidelines, minimum wage exemptions and follows all required rules and regulations, noted in O. Regulation 285/01.
