- Cost for PA Day camp is \$70 per day.
- Open drop-off is available in the morning between 8:30am – 9am
- Open pick-up is available at the end of the day between 4pm – 4:30pm.
- Regular camp program hours are 9am to 4pm.
- Extended care is available for the end of the day from 4:30pm – 5:30pm for \$12 per day.

Registration can be done online. Full payment is due at the time of registration. Our online payment application does not accept deposits. Full refunds for PA Day camps are available (minus an admin fee of \$15) are available with 14 days written notice. Payment can be made by Visa-Debit, Visa or Mastercard.
