**Learn to Ride:** Open to campers 7-12 years old – Busing available.

# Campers must be 7 years old as of December 31, 2025, to register for riding camp.

Have a child who loves animals and is keen to learn to ride? Pawsitively Pets has a great program for our animal-loving friends who love horses and want to be introduced to horseback riding! Our Learn to Ride program allows children to be introduced to the wonderful world of horses and riding and still have the chance to enjoy a weekly visit from the Pawsitively Pets animal team each week. The program includes daily horsemanship activities, horse interactions, two mounted riding lessons, a weekly hands-on animal presentations and horse-related crafts/enrichment. Horse show for parents on final day.

2025 camp will be run at Redwood Stables in Uxbridge.

**3 LEVELS NOW AVAILABLE!** Many riders have been riding throughout the year and improving their skills. We will now have 3 levels available. Please read the information below carefully to ensure you select the right level. It is easier for us to challenge your rider at a lower level than have them struggle to keep up at a level they are not ready for.

**LEVEL 1 -** is meant for new riders who have never ridden and/or have only been to camp 1-3 times and have not ridden since last summer. Usually, riders need to do Level 1 three to five times before moving to Level 2 - We always group our Level 1 riders into skill levels, so those who came to camp last summer will be grouped with other riders who joined us last summer, and our brand-new riders who have never attended camp will be grouped together.

**LEVEL 2** – is meant for riders who can walk and post trot independently without a leader and have the full ability to steer their horse at a walk and trot. This level is often well suited for campers who have been to camp and done Level 1 several times and Level 2 once or twice but do not ride regularly throughout the year. This is also a good fit for riders who have just started lessons.

**LEVEL 3** – is meant for riders who take regular lessons (ride outside of camp for at least half of the year) and can walk, trot and canter.

# Busing Available from our Leaside – 125 BRENTCLIFFE ROAD Location ONLY for riding camp

Riding campers will be bused with our staff to our Riding Partner – Redwood Stables in Uxbridge.

- Camp hours are 9am to 4pm (bus arrives at the farm between 9-915am in the morning at camp, and we begin to load at 345pm to plan for a 4pm departure.)
- AM Bus pick-up at Brentcliffe is 8am and drop-off at the end of the day is 5pm.
- The program does not have the option for extended care.
- Busing is available at an additional cost. 4-day program \$80 + HST/5-day program \$100 + HST
- All fees include helmet rental; all campers must have a boot with a heel for camp a rainboot works well.
- All campers must bring a packed lunch, two snacks and two large water bottles.

#### PLEASE NOTE – THERE ARE NO DISCOUNTS AVAILABLE FOR RIDING CAMP.

Camp fees are exempt from HST, but HST is charged for all busing/transportation fees.

All campers must be 7 years old or older as of December 31 to sign up for the Learn to Ride Program

### 2025 Summer Camp REFUND POLICY:

Refunds for all programs will be made in writing by email and will be refunded in accordance with the schedule below. Credit can be obtained for the full amount of the refund to use towards another program if the guidelines noted below are met and the program date is within the same calendar year.

# Summer Camp Refunds Schedule with Notice:

- Full-week sessions minus the \$65 admin fee or a credit can be applied to your account with no administration fee available until May 31.
- By-the-day refunds minus \$15 admin fee per day or a credit can be applied to your account with no administration fee available until May 31.
- 50% credit is available with notice provided with 30 days or more notice prior to the start of your camp date.
- After May 31 no refunds are available.
- Transferring to a different session changes to the dates you are registered for camp can be made up to 21 days before the start of your camp date based on availability and must fall within the same camp season.

<sup>\*\*</sup>Refunds with less notice are available if we can fill your spot with someone from our waiting list. Please note, our waiting list/transfer administrative fee is \$75 per full-week session and \$25 for a by-the-day session. You are also welcome to see if you have a friend or family member to take your spot, and we will transfer the spot to them subject to a \$25 transfer fee; we require a minimum of 2 business days to transfer a spot to another participant.
